

Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS) Monthly Report for February 2006

Data Exchange: USIIS is currently working with Medicaid on exchanging immunization data for patients of all ages. It looks like the information USIIS will receive will greatly increase our immunization information on patients over the age of 18. **Contact Nancy Paré at 801-538-6871 or npare@utah.gov.**

Functionality: Each week a USIIS staff member logs into WebKIDS in order to test the functionality and speed of its use. Results from January 2005 to January 2006 show that WebKIDS had a problem rate of .06%, and is accessible, functioning properly, and has adequate response time 99.9% of the time during which tests were performed. **Contact Sandra Schulthies at 801-538-9452.**

EIMS: Data entry should be easy using simple key strokes to complete form data through EIMS. In drop-down lists, you can scroll down possible entries by simply entering the first letter of the entry. For example, in a list that is alphabetized, you can quickly go to the first entry in that list that contains the letter W by hitting the w key, and the second in the list by hitting the w key a second time. WebKIDS User Tip: If you find that you are looking at a red X in the upper corner of your screen instead of the WebKIDS application, you can fix this in two ways. The first way is to close all of the active windows open. Then go to the Start button, and then to the control panel. In the control panel select the "add/remove programs" applications. In this program you will find a list of all of the program installed on your computer. Search for anything that has to do with Java and select it. Choose the remove program on every one of the Java programs. After all of the Java programs have been removed, then restart your computer. Open up Internet Explorer and find your way to <http://java.sun.com/products/archive/index.html>. On this list is a version that will work. Select the version 1.4.2_09 from the J2SDK/J2RE – 1.4 items. Download the J2RE to the desktop, and when it is finished, install it with all the default settings. This should fix your problem. Shots Invalid: WebKIDS is reporting some immunizations as being invalid when they are actually valid. We are aware of the problem and are working to correct it as soon as possible. The shots WebKIDS is incorrectly marking as invalid are Hepatitis A and Tdap. Hp A can now be given as soon as 12 months of age. Tdap can be given as 11 years of age. As soon as the forecast is corrected in WebKIDS, the immunizations incorrectly indicated as invalid will be shown as valid. **Contact Chris Pratt at 801-538-9945 or cpratt@utah.gov.**
