

Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS) Monthly Report for May 2006

Forecast : The USIIS Immunization Forecast is accurate, dependable, and includes all of the official recommendations and rules from the advisory committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). It forecasts when the next dose of vaccine is due for children, adolescents and adults. A recent survey shows that the USIIS forecast is second to none, and superior to most other states' immunization registry forecasts. **Contact Sandra Schulthies at 801-538-9452.**

EIMS System Requirements: EIMS is best viewed on a screen size of 800 x 600 or better. This is actually quite a small resolution for modern computers. This was done to accommodate users that might have older PCs. EIMS, because most of the computing and data querying is done on the server, has very low system requirements. Enrollment: There were several new enrollments during May. WebKIDS User Tip: Have you been getting a pop-up message about site certificates? If you have, and you want to get rid of it, just follow these simple steps. First, make sure the window I am writing about and the one you are getting is the same one. The one I am describing has three buttons on the bottom: "Yes," "No," and "View Certificate." The button you should click is the "View Certificate" button, and then click the "Install Certificate" button. It will run you through a series of "Yes" and "Next" buttons. Just accept the defaults and save when it asks you to do so. The next time you go to WebKIDS, this pop-up should be gone. If you have any problems, or for more information on this tip, **contact J.C.
