

Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS) Monthly Report for June 2006

Reminder/Recall: USIIS is currently sending immunization reminder/recall postcards for 7 local health departments and 5 community health centers. We send reminders only for public providers due to budget constraints. Private clinics using WebKIDS can produce lists of their patients who are due or overdue for the next immunization by using the Reminder-recall Summary Report. **Contact Sandra Schulthies at 801-538-9452.**

EIMS: This month a new SSL security certificate was installed for the production environment. Thawte was selected as the certificate vendor because of two important reasons: low cost and that fact that all browsers support their certificate with no modification. Users that were seeing a pop-up that said "the certificate was not signed by a trusted certificate authority" will no longer receive that message. Other users who had accepted the previous certificate will notice no change during log in. Enrollment: There were 3 providers, 6 daycare centers and 2 schools enrolled in June. They are: Douglas Walker DO, Clinica de Buena Salud, CHC, IHC Sandy Instacare, Early Childhood Education Center, Little Brigham Aggies, YWCA Lolie Eccles Child Care Center, Discovery Club House, Jordan Child Development Center, Kid Power Child Care, Syracuse Arts Academy and Ogden Prep Middle School. WebKIDS User Tip: The school report will auto-populate the parent/guardian information automatically, but in order to do so, the record in WebKIDS needs to be filled out correctly. In the Patinfo screen there are three places for this information: Mother's Information, Father's Information, and Guardian Information. If the mother's information and the father's information are filled out, the mother's shows up on the school report. If you want the father's information to show up instead of the mother's, you need to place his information in the Guardian section. If just the father's information is filled out, then the father shows up on the school report. So the order of precedence is: Guardian, Mother, and then Father. Also, please remember that you can update or change this information yourself. However, you cannot replace filled out information with blank information. More on SSL: WebKIDS uses an SSL certificate to ensure a secure and encrypted connection between the web server and users' browsers. Since the fall of 2005 this

certificate has made WebKIDS non-functional for Apple Macintosh users using Internet Explorer as their browser. As a work-around these users have been running WebKIDS in other browsers such as Safari. USIIS recently renewed this certificate and utilized a different certificate authority than was previously used. The certificate now in place has corrected the problem that Macintosh users were experiencing.
