

## **Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS) Monthly Report for March 2005**

**Immunization Rates by Zip Code:** USIIS has successfully implemented a geographic mapping function. Up-to-date rates can be calculated for any number of antigens and any age group. **Enrollment/Training:** There was one new enrollment for March: Central Utah Youth Center. There were 2 re-enrollments and 8 trainings for current providers and schools. **Contact Linda Abel at 801-538-6905 or [label@utah.gov](mailto:label@utah.gov).**

**WebKIDS User Tip:** The best way to do a search on a patient in WebKIDS is to use the patient's first name, last name and date of birth. Use no more or no less information than this. Always try to get the parent or guardian to give you the CORRECT patient's name (as listed on the birth certificate). This will help in many ways: a better chance for a match; fewer non-matching records created in WebKIDS that need a human to correct; and to remind the parent to use this name for official purposes. **WebKIDS Deployment:** The most recent USIIS deployment was successful and contained the following items:

- The Immunization screen's lot number drop down list now displays expired lot numbers if the expiration date is equal to or after the vaccination date;
- Vaccinations are now editable with or without a lot number in the lots drop-down list;
- In the Immune screen, Forecast screen and Forecast report, the series field is now large enough to display the difference between PNEUMO PVC and PNEUMO (PPV23);
- A message was added to both the patient and admin Reports tabs indicating that pop-up blockers may prevent a report from working;
- The ability to add Hep-B 2 Dose shots (code 943) to the historical entry screen was added and placed under the Hep-B series list;
- Changes to the Doses Administered Report included a change to the look of the set-up screen to be more user friendly and to allow providers to view reports submitted in past quarters. Additionally, instructions on this page are more clear and explain the functionality changes;

- In the Immunization entry screen, users can now type in a vaccinator name and it will auto-display the name as it is entered. Also the delete and backspace keys can now be used;
- When a vaccine date entered is earlier than the patient's date of birth, the field is now cleared after the warning message is displayed;
- The Historical Data Entry screen now refreshes after deleting a vaccine that was just entered;
- A bug that did not allow some users to log in was fixed;
- Some AIMS report buttons were enabled for use.
