WebKIDS User Tip: When adding a new patient, keep in mind that the minimum amount of information is not the best amount. A small investment of time on your part can save time for others and make the data better. If it is as simple as asking the mother her maiden name, please do so. If you add the address it will benefit you and others in the future by being available for matching and reports. WebKIDS Deployment: The April USIIS deployment was successful and contained the following items:

- Vaccine Reaction: changes will now force a user to add a reaction note if the user chooses a reaction type of “O” ther.
- Inventory counts will adjust for lots when a lot number is changed in the immunization screen.
- Funding category for an existing lot number will now be editable
- A bug that was showing inventory information for other clinics has been fixed.
- The “Vaccine Series” sort option in the Set-up Conditions for the Clinic History Report has been removed. It has never worked well, and is seldom used.
- A bug that prevents a shot from being saved after it has been deleted has been fixed.

- The Date field in the Doses Administered Report screen now has a character limit.
- A problem deleting an “All” exemption when it is a “C” record has been fixed.
